Beauvale Charterhouse was founded in 1343 by Nicholas de Cantilupe, the third of nine priories to be built dedicated to the Carthusian order of monks.

Monks lived a strict, silent life here at Beauvale for nearly 200 years until the dissolution of the monasteries when they refused to sign the oath of supremacy acknowledging Henry VIII as head of the church. John Houghton and Robert Lawrence (previous and present) Priors of Beauvale were the first to be hanged, drawn and quartered at Tyburn on the 4th May 1535.

The Bishop of Nottingham leads a pilgrimage on the Sunday closest to the 4th May every year in memory of the two Martyrs'.

Beauvale is in part of D.H.Lawrence's "Country of my Heart" and features in a couple of his novels as The Abbey and he writes a short story based here called "A Fragment of Stained Glass".

We bought the farm in 2006 with the intention of leading a quiet self-sufficient life. It was derelict and extremely run down, so we arrived with our caravan, which we lived in for a year whilst we renovated the farm cottage.

English Heritage approached us wanting to consolidate the ruins of the Priory, the arch window was in great danger of collapsing in. They consider this to be one of the most important monastic sites in the country and what we have here are the 2nd most remains of a Carthusian Charterhouse after Mount Grace Priory, including the only piece of woodwork, which is a very impressive beamed ceiling in the guesthouse which is the building attached to the gatehouse. After extensive consolidation works that took over 3 years, the arch window and north wall have been saved. Work has now started to consolidate part of the Gatehouse range. Once completed this will become an educational classroom

We are part of Natural England's higher-level stewardship scheme and offer educational access visits, free of charge. Access to the ruins are available free of charge whilst the Tearooms are open. Guided tours and talks of the ruins can be arranged with a minimum of 6 people. £1 donation per person towards the ongoing consolidation of the ruins.
